Farmers Market Permit Information

The Farmers Market Permit was created for businesses and organizations who intend to sell their products at multiple markets in Whitman County.

Permit Details

The Farmers Market Permit is limited to use at the following markets:

- Pullman Market Monday
- Pullman Market on Main
- Garfield Farmers Market
- Colfax Farmers Market
- St. John Farmers Market
- Palouse Grown Market
- Palouse Farmers Market

This list of approved markets is subject to change as markets are added or dissolved throughout the county.

If a permit holder is found operating at an event that is not on the list of approved markets using their Farmers Market Permit, they will be asked to purchase a Temporary Food Establishment Permit for that event.

Businesses and organizations that only intend to attend one market per year will obtain a Temporary Food Establishment Permit.

Current Fee Schedule

Permit Type	Description	Multi Market Fee
Exemption Permit	Pre-packaged, non-TCS foods; Whole, uncut fruits and vegetables (excludes fungi and sprouts)	\$0
Egg Seller Permit	Eggs with WSDA license and DOR stickers	\$30
Benevolent Market Permit	Issued to nonprofit organizations	\$30
Simple Market Permit	Involving two or less processes*	\$75
Complex Market Permit	Involving three or more processes*	\$150

*Thawing, portioning, cooking, cooling, hot holding, cold holding, reheating
